Students are encouraged to ask questions and express their concerns about pertinent issues. A major goal of the academy is to increase understanding between citizens and their Sheriff's Department, and to build strong relations for the future good of the community.

Requirements: Only participants who can dedicate their time to 6 sessions should apply.

1. You must be at least 21 years or older
2. No outstanding warrants and no pending criminal cases
3. No prior felony convictions
4. No misdemeanor arrest within three years of application
5. No Domestic/DUI and or Sex Offence Charge
6. Pass background check
